Bible- Our Bible curriculum comes from the Jesus Storybook Bible. The children learn about Old and New Testament Heroes and the Godly virtues and characteristics that each model. Along with the Bible stories there is a monthly Bible memory verse. Once a week the children meet together for Chapel in the Sanctuary, which includes singing, a Bible lesson and praying before they go to their class. Parents are encouraged to join us for our morning Chapel time.

Reading and Language Arts

Our Language Arts and Reading curriculum comes from **Wonders, McGraw Hill**. This curriculum is composed of 10 units.

Some of the skills that are learned include:

- Print Awareness
- Phonological Awareness
- Phonics
- Reading Strategies
- Reading Fluency
- Vocabulary Development
- Reading Comprehension
- Writing and Writing Process
- Oral and Written conventions of Handwriting, Capitalization, Punctuation, and Spelling

Sight words/high frequency words are also introduced to increase the student's reading vocabulary.

Journal Writing- The goal of journal writing is to get the student thinking more about how letter sounds form words. During journaling the student is encouraged to work independently to form words and sentences.

Spelling- Spelling is introduced half way through the school year. It consists of a list of 5 rhyming words and a bonus word.

MATH

My Math is our math curriculum. It is a hands-on approach to learning math concepts. The objectives covered are:

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- Counting and cardinality
- Operations and Algebraic Thinking
- Number and Operations in Base Ten
- Measurement and Data
- Geometry
- Money and Time

Homework- Homework includes the following: writing practice, phonics, math and reading.
